0	Arrange for transportation to be at the boathouse within 5 minutes after the end of each adult recreational session.	
0	Understand that violation of these rules and guidelines can result in termination of the rower's membership in the adult recreational program and forfeiture of membership dues.	
0	Membership dues for the summer are \$50 for youth rowers. Membership dues for coxswains is free. Membership ends on the last day of August.
