signing this agreement, agree to:

- Recognize that membership in the adult recreational program is a privilege, not a right.
- Since this is an adult recreational program, there can be no "all" high school boats. These sessions are not "coached" and typically coaches' launches do not accompany the rowers.
- Just as adult members are requested to take a turn acting as coxswain, youth members may also be asked to participate similarly.
- Show respect, in both actions and words, for fellow rowers, coaches, officials and all others who volunteer their time.
- Dress and behave in a manner that is a credit to him/herself and CLRA crew.
- Refrain from acting in a reckless manner that could put the rower and/or others at risk for injury.
- Refrain from any behavior that is intimidating, hostile or offensive in any way, including but not limited to the use of foul/abusive language.
- Arrange for transportation to be at the boathouse within 5 minutes after the end of each adult recreational session.
- Understand that violation of these rules and guidelines can result in termination of the rower's membership in the adult recreational program and forfeiture of membership dues.
- Membership dues for the summer are \$50 for youth rowers. Membership dues for coxswains is free. Membership ends on the last day of August.
