High School Summer Rowing / Coxing:

Any active CLRA high school team member in good standing, other than graduating senior, is eligible to row or act as coxswain / steersman during the summer master's recreation rows. Eligibility starts at the end of the high school season through summer until the start of school in the fall.

Students are not permitted to row / cox separate, high school only boats. They may participate only during regularly scheduled masters' practices. These practices do not typically have a coach boat traveling with the shells and consequently are different than a normal high school practice. There is a simple application to complete.

Rowers: Cost is \$50.00.

Coxswains / Steersman: Free

Graduating Seniors:

Any CLRA high school senior graduating team member in good standing, is eligible to participate as a full CLRA member during the masters' summer and fall season in the year of their graduation. Eligibility starts at the end of the high school season in their graduating year.

These members are permitted to practice with the masters on regularly scheduled practice times. These individuals may also set up their own boats during the masters practice sessions but must work with the masters' coordinators to assure safety, effective use and sharing of equipment as necessary.

Rowers: Cost is \$50.00.

Coxswains / Steersman: Free
