## Chautauqua Lake Rowing High School Club Team Registration Procedure

- 1. CLRA registration: go to web site, www.rowchautauqua.org to the "High School Registration" tab. Go to button "Registration Open!". This takes you to TeamSnap registration page. Register in TeamSnap site completing all the required information. Make sure you check that you wish to receive email and SMS (alerts/text messages). Step 2 is to download / read the current year Parent Athlete Handbook. NEW in 2024: US Rowing requires that an athlete is capable of swimming as with details noted in the Handbook. Both parent and athlete should read the policies in the Handbook. Print the last page; both parent and student should complete the signature page. Bring this page to your first on site practice. The next step is payment. There are 3 selections: Rower, Coxswain, & Coach. If you are a Rower, you would select Rower or select coxswain if that is your primary role. NOTE: the security deposit of \$100 is included with the dues total. It is refundable as in the past if the athlete complies with the requirements in the handbook. You can make your payment on line using credit card (Visa or Master Card). A transaction fee charged by the card companies is added to the final total. You may also elect to pay by cash or check at practice. Athletes should be paid in full no later than the first day of practice. Kathleen McCarthy Scholarships are available for those in financial need. Information is on our web site. Retain passwords for future use of the site.
- 2. <u>US Rowing Waiver</u>: <u>Choose the BASIC Membership</u> There are several levels of membership within US Rowing. The only one required for the High School Club Team is the Basic Membership for the cost of \$25.00. For Kathleen McCarthy Scholarship applicants, see our web site. The Team does not prohibit you from joining US Rowing at a different level, but it is **NOT** required. Only Basic Level is necessary. Also, there is **NO** requirement for you to donate to US Rowing. If no donation is made, you need to select "Not Now" for the donation questions. The button to US Rowing can be found under the High School page. Click the "US Rowing On-Line Waiver" button. On the US Rowing site, under <u>Individuals</u> click "Join" for new team members or "Members, Renew/Upgrade" for returning athletes. You will be asked for information and maybe some rowing questions. Associate with team: Chautauqua Lake Rowing. **Team Code: N4RSC**. Retain passwords for future use of the site. Note that your member number is used for your USRowing login in addition to a password.
- 3. <u>Registration Day</u>: There is <u>NO</u> off site registration location. For your first practice, have your registration complete, US Rowing waiver signed on-line, and bring the signed handbook form. If you are paying in person instead of on-line bring check (or cash) for dues and security deposit.
- 4. **Phone App**: To have update information including schedules, directions, etc. go to your phone's App Store. Download the app TeamSnap, Sports Team Management. Parents can also obtain this app. This is a great way to stay current on our schedule or see if there are any upcoming events. The app can also be used to set up the calendar app on the phone.
